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PURPOSE

The Camden Special Services District (CSSD) seeks a qualified PR consultant to provide media relations and publicity services on a 12 month retainer.

ABOUT OUR ORGANIZATION

The Camden Special Services District (CSSD) was incorporated as a 501c3 in 2005 under the umbrella of the Camden Community Partnership. In 2019 CSSD was the designated as the management corporation for the Downtown Camden Business Improvement District (CBID) and became its own independent organization, funded primarily through a special property assessment, charged with providing cleaning, greening, marketing, and business support services to foster a clean, safe, and inviting place to work, live, and visit.

CSSD regularly hosts events in downtown Camden and partners with other organizations to market their events. Our events serve several purposes: activating underutilized downtown spaces, bringing new audiences to spend time in the city (i.e. workers in downtown office buildings who rarely visit the city's offerings), and attracting media coverage. Recent events include the Downtown Camden Art Crawl, Lunchtime Concert Series, and a community picnic at Roosevelt Plaza Park. The selected consultant should have some experience or familiarity with place management organizations.

ABOUT DOWNTOWN CAMDEN

Camden New Jersey is a city of 71,000 residents, only 2,400 of whom live within what is considered to be "downtown." This district is characterized by government offices (such as City Hall), higher education campuses, medical campuses, waterfront tourist attractions, and vast parking lots that accommodate the 21,000 commuters who come into downtown to work at corporations such as Subaru, Campbells, Coriell Institute, Lockheed Martin, and Holtec.

Regionally, Camden is perhaps best known for its waterfront attractions such as Adventure Aquarium, Battleship New Jersey, Wiggins Marina, and Freedom Mortgage Pavillion. But it is also a growing Eds & Meds center with Cooper University Hospital, Virtua, Rutgers University—Camden, and Cooper Rowan Medical School. Residents in the region are likely most familiar with events such as the Camden County Summer Concert Series and Xponential Music Festival. CSSD strives to promote events and activities on the Market Street corridor and Roosevelt Plaza Park (City Hall) that welcome visitors to our district, encourage people to shop local, and build community amongst residents, workers, and business owners.

OVERVIEW

The goal of services outlined in this RFP is to raise the profile throughout the Greater Philadelphia region of Downtown Camden and its business and cultural offerings. As the business improvement district for Camden's downtown and waterfront, we aim to increase positive press coverage, transform the city's public narrative, and attract visitors and investors to our commercial district.

SCOPE & DELIVERABLES

The scope of work presented is based upon circumstances existing at the time the RFP is released.

This contract is not to exceed \$20,000 per year.

1. Media relations & outreach

- a. Manage ongoing media relations outreach with local, regional, and national media outlets
- b. Writing and distribution of press release for CSSD and partners
- c. Build relationships with local journalists with particular attention to those with business and economic development beats
- d. Facilitate collaborative storytelling with other Camden or South Jersey organizations
- e. Identify upcoming major regional events/stories and create tie-ins for Camden
- f. Suggest social media partnerships, influencers, and post ideas based on work

2. Media Calendar

- a. In collaboration with CSSD staff, build a monthly calendar for pitching, press releases, and opportunities
- b. Identify seasonal tie ins with Camden businesses, such as Black History Month, Mothers Day, summer fun, etc.

3. Reporting

- a. Quarterly strategy reviews and performance assessments
- b. Meet with CSSD staff to discuss projects and strategies as needed

- c) The award of the contract for this RFP shall be made pending approval and funding authorization to do the work is provided to the Camden Special Services District in a lawful manner.

Goods, General Services, and Professional Service Contracts (Mandatory Affirmative Action Language)

During the performance of this contract, the Contractor agrees as follows:

The Contractor or Subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the Contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation or sex.

The Contractor or Subcontractor, where applicable, will send to each labor union or representative or workers with which it has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer, advising the labor union or workers' representative of the Contractor's commitments under this act and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment. The Contractor or Subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The Contractor or Subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to employ minority and women workers consistent with the applicable county employment goals established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2 or a binding determination of the applicable county employment goals determined by the Division, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2.

The Contractor or Subcontractor agrees to inform in writing its appropriate recruitment agencies including, but not limited to, employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital

status, affectional or sexual orientation or sex, and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.

The Contractor or Subcontractor agrees to revise any of its testing procedures, if necessary, to assure that all personnel testing conforms with the principles of job-related testing, as established by the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey, and as established by applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

In conforming with the applicable employment goals, the Contractor or Subcontractor agrees to review all procedures relating to transfer, upgrading, downgrading and layoff to ensure that all such actions are taken without regard to age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation or sex, consistent with the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey, and applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions. All successful prospects must submit, within seven (7) days after the receipt of the notice of intent to award that contract or the receipt of the contract, one of the following:

The Proposer shall indemnify, protect, and save harmless the OWNER, its agents, servants, and employees from and against any and all suits, claims, losses, demands, or damages, of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of the alleged violation. The PROPOSER shall at its own expense, appear, defend any pay any and all charges for legal services and any and all costs and other expenses arising from such action or administrative proceeding or incurred in connection therewith. In any and all complaints brought pursuant to the OWNER'S grievance procedure, the PROPOSER agrees to abide by any decision of the OWNER which is rendered pursuant to said grievance procedure. Furthermore, the PROPOSER expressly understands and agrees that the provisions of this indemnification clause shall in no way limit the Proposer's obligations assumed in this Agreement, nor shall they be construed to relieve the PROPOSER from any liability, nor preclude the OWNER from taking any other actions available to it under any other provisions of the Agreement or otherwise at law.

EXHIBIT F NEW JERSEY BUSINESS REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS — NON-CONSTRUCTION

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:32-44, the CSSD is prohibited from entering into a contract with an entity unless the bidder/proposer/contractor, and each subcontractor that is required by law to be named in a bid/proposal/contract has a valid Business Registration Certificate on file with the Division of Revenue and Enterprise Services within the Department of the Treasury.

Prior to contract award or authorization, the contractor shall provide the Contracting Agency with its proof of business registration and that of any named subcontractor(s).

Subcontractors named in a bid or other Bid shall provide proof of business registration to the bidder, who in turn, shall provide it to the Contracting Agency prior to the time a contract, purchase order, or other contracting document is awarded or authorized.

During the course of contract performance:

- (1) the contractor shall not enter into a contract with a subcontractor unless the subcontractor first provides the contractor with a valid proof of business registration.
- (2) the contractor shall maintain and submit to the Contracting Agency a list of subcontractors and their addresses that may be updated from time to time.
- (3) the contractor and any subcontractor providing goods or performing services under the contract, and each of their affiliates, shall collect and remit to the Director of the Division of Taxation in the Department of the Treasury, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act, (N.J.S.A. 54:32B-1 et seq.) on all sales of tangible personal property delivered into the State. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:49-4.1, a business organization that fails to provide a copy of a business registration as required, or that provides false business registration information, shall be liable for a penalty of \$25 for each day of violation, not to exceed \$50,000, for each proof of business registration not properly provided under a contract with a contracting agency.
